

Rules for Watercraft (includes Boats, Jet-skis, Kayaks, Canoes, etc.)

- All watercraft must be listed on reservation before or at time of reservation.
- All trailered watercraft must remain in Boat Parking at all times while on Park property.
- Trailered watercraft are not allowed to be parked at/or in RV sites.
- Loading/unloading items from watercraft is allowed at your site for 15-20 minutes. Do not block roadways and you **must not** interfere with RV's that are arriving and leaving a site.
- Watercraft of any kind, apart from kayaks (which must be *carried* to the water's edge), may not be launched from Lake Pointe Property. Directions to Boat Ramp 17 (across from Lake Pointe) are available upon request.

____<mark>I understand a \$75 fine will be imposed if, at any time, a Guest or Member fails to comply with the above rules.</mark>

Failure to comply with the following Corp. of Engineer's (COE) rules may result in Lake Pointe's inability to have access to the water's edge. You may review the current COE rules (*Title 36 Rules), regarding Canyon Lake access, in the Front Office.

- No motorized vehicles (including golf carts) are allowed to be driven to the water's edge per the COE (*see Section 327.2 (b).
- If watercraft are left over 24 hours at the water's edge, the COE may consider them abandoned, and has the right to take possession and levy fines (*see Section 327.15 (a)(b).)
